Gentlemen:

Under letter dated March 15, 1974, Cities Service requested an exception to requirements of Rule 104 for the Government X No. 1. We have been advised by the USGS the proposed location falls on the same base lease as our recently completed Elizondo Federal A No. 1 and therefore other wells drilled on this lease should be numbered consecutively.


Cities Service Oil Company respectfully requests an exception to the well location requirements of Rule 104 for the Elizondo Federal A No. 2 at a proposed location 1980' FSL, 1780' FWL, Section 21, T-21-S, R-27-E, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, with the proration unit to be comprised of the S/2 of Section 21. The regular location is 57' west of the Southwest Public Service primary distribution line. To prevent any possible contact with the high voltage line during drilling or possible subsequent workover operations, it is proposed to move the location 200' west of a 1980' orthodox location.

As provided in Rule 104-F, we request an exception be granted without notice and hearing. The offset operator to the east of the proposed proration unit has been notified by certified mail. The Cities Service operated Magruder Unit offsets the proposed proration unit in all remaining directions.

Your early handling of this matter will be appreciated.

Dear Mr. Gengler:

Reference is made to your application dated August 12, 1992 for a non-standard La Huerta Strawn/Atoka gas well location for your existing Elizando "A" Federal Well No. 2Y which was drilled in 1974 and completed in the Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location (Division Administrative Order NSL-649) 1880 feet from the South line and 1780 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Morrow interval has been recently plugged back and said well has been recompleted up-hole to both the Undesignated La Huerta-Strawn Gas Pool and Undesignated La Huerta-Atoka Gas Pool, where, pursuant to Division Administrative Order DHC-861, dated September 24, 1992, both gas streams will be downhole commingled.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1), the unorthodox location in both gas zones is hereby approved. Further, the S/2 of said Section 21 shall be dedicated to said well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both pools.

The provisions of said Order NSL-649 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
