



Gentlemen:

Atlantic Richfield Company, as operator of the Russell Turner Waterflood Project, requests administrative approval under provisions of Order No. R-3185 (3) for the drilling of the C. A. Russell No. 11 (exact location on attached exhibit) as an unorthodox location.
