Application of Atlantic Richfield Company for an Unorthodox Gas Well Location, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks approval of an Unorthodox Gas Well Location 660 feet South of the North Line and 1,830 feet East of the West Line of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 26 East to Test the Morrow Zone of Pennsylvanian age and the Dedication to said well of the North-Half (N/2) of said Section 16.

Comes Atlantic Richfield Company, acting by and through, the undersigned attorney, and hereby makes application for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location. Said location is 660 feet South of the North line and 1,830 feet East of the West line of Section 16, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, said well to be projected to approximately 10,500 feet to test the Morrow Zone of Pennsylvania age, and the dedication to said well of the North-Half (N/2) of said Section 16. In support of this application, the Applicant respectfully shows:

- 1. Statewide Rule 104 specifies that an orthodox well location will be 1,980 feet from the nearest end boundary and 660 feet from the nearest side boundary. Upon surveying the subject tract for the well location, it was found that the prescribed location from the nearest end boundary would be only 37 feet from a pipeline running in a north-south direction as shown on a plat attached hereto.
- 2. Applicant believes that the proposed unorthodox location is the most strategic position to obtain production from the Morrow Zone of Pennsylvania age.
- 3. The North-Half (N/2) of said Section 16 is land of the State of New Mexico and is covered by oil and gas leaseholds owned by the Applicant, Amoco Production Company and Cities Service Oil Company, all of which have approved and agreed to the drilling of the proposed well, which will be designated as State BR Com. No. 2.
- 4. It is believed that the granting of this application is justified in the interest of conservation, prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.
- 5. Attached hereto is a plat showing the ownership of all leases offsetting the spacing unit for which the unorthodox location is sought and also all wells completed thereon. Also attached is a plat showing the location of pipelines which necessitate moving from an orthodox location to an unorthodox location.
- 6. The offset operators are Gulf Oil Corporation, whose address is Post Office Box 1150, Midland, Texas 79701 and Coquina Oil Corporation, whose address is 200 Building of the Southwest, Midland, Texas 79701, both of whom have

been sent copies of the application by certified mail. Applicant operates the units North and East of the subject unit.




