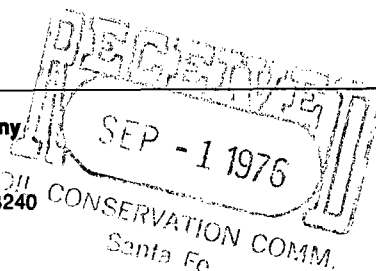

Gentlemen:

Unorthodox Location - Jicarilla 22 Well No. 8 - I-16-25N-4W, West Lindrith
Dakota Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico

Application for permit to drill subject well dated August 9, 1976 was forwarded to your Aztec office via the USGS office in Durango. The well is proposed to be located 1795' FSL and 1080' FEL. The pool rules for the pool contained in Order No. R-4314, Rule 4, requires a well to be located no nearer than 330' to the quarter-quarter section line. Rule 5 provides that exceptions may be granted for topographic reasons.

The proposed location is located in a narrow valley between two bluffs. A location 990' FEL in conformance with the rules would require approximately 80' of cut into one of the bluffs. There is also a pipeline running through this valley which limits the flexibility of alternate locations. This lease consists of Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22. Continental Oil Company is also the owner of an adjoining lease consisting of Section 17 and other lands. Therefore, the nearest acreage of diversified ownership is located approximately one mile to the northwest. It is respectfully requested that the unorthodox location described above be approved under the provisions of Rule 5 of the special pool rules contained in Order No. R-4314 and that the 20 day waiting period be waived in view of the lack of offset operators within one mile.


