Reference is made to your application on behalf of James P. Woosley for approval of a non-standard location for his Navajo "AA" Well No. 27 to be located 178 feet from the South line and 2040 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 17 West, NMPM, North Many Rocks-Lower Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Since there are no offsetting operators, the waiting period prescribed by Rule 104 F may be dispensed with in this instance.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F of the Commission Rules and Regulations, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
