The data accompanying your application demonstrates that the proposed change in production allocation is justified.


Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be on the following basis unless further modified with permission of the Aztec District Office and copied to this office:

Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool	Oil-100%	Gas-99%
Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool	Oil-0%	Gas-1%

Pursuant to Rule 303.C.(2), the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
