Amoco Production Company respectfully requests administrative approval for an unorthodox location for our Williams Gas Com Well No. 1, located 560 feet FNL and 1980 feet FWL, Unit C, Section 21, T 19 S, R 24 E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Approval is requested based upon topographical conditions.

The orthodox drillsite, located 660 feet FNL and 1980 feet FWL, would have placed the well in a concrete canal used for irrigation by Carlsbad Irrigation Company. A house, corrals, and a barn prevented the movement of the well east, and the only location available is the unorthodox location at 560 feet FNL and 1980 feet FWL. The deposition trend of the reef discouraged us from moving the well to the south.
