Application For Non-Standard Location, San Juan 29-4 Well No. 23, SE/4 of Section 15-T29N-R4W, Wildcat Pictured Cliffs. Rio Arriba County, NM NSV 45 NSV 45 Rule 1, 1978

By this application submitted in triplicate, we respectfully request your administrative approval for a non-standard location due to topography for San Juan 29-4 Well No. 23 to be located 2180' FSL and 1580' FEL of Section 15-T29N-R4W. Attached is a topography map showing conditions which forced the non-standard location.

Application for a permit to drill and an environmental analysis in compliance with NTL-6 have already been filed by our Farmington Area office with the USGS on this wildcat Pictured Cliffs location.

The standard locations for wildcat gas wells in Rio Arriba County must be 130' from the quarter-quarter section boundaries and 790' from the exterior boundary of each spacing unit as shown on the attached topographic map. The designated spacing unit for San Juan 29-4 Well No. 23 is the SE/4 of Section 15. A review of the topographic map shows that a standard location for this well would be very difficult and expensive to drill, due to the topography of this area. The proposed location of 2180' FSL and 1580' FEL of Section 15 is in a much flatter area requiring less expense and surface disruption to build.

Amoco owns 100% working interest in the San Juan 29-4 Nos. 21, 22 and 23 wells. El Paso Natural Gas Company will operate the wells as Operator of the San Juan 29-4 Unit. The nonstandard location for San Juan 29-4 Well No. 23 is a move north towards Amoco held offset acreage. Offset owners


