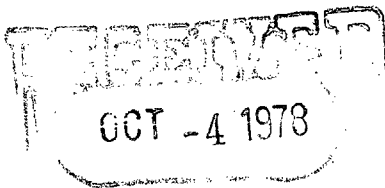

Gentlemen:

Attached please find three copies of Form C-102, Land Plat & Sketch showing surface obstructions, all pertaining to the proposed O. J. Dowling Well No. 1 Location. The proposed drill site will be at an unorthodox location because of topographic obstructions as shown on the attached plat.


As shown on the plat, the Proration Unit is divided by a Federal Highway. On the north side of the highway, there is a chemical plant which covers a large portion of the lease. On the south side of the highway, there are power lines, a buried telephone cable, the E. J. Garner residence, three inhabited trailer houses and an abandoned sanitary land fill. A well drilled at the standard location (660' FEL & 1980' FSL) would be in close proximity to the Garner residence and the Federal Highway. By moving the drill site to the proposed location, the distance from the Garner residence and the Federal Highway would be approximately doubled. In addition, the buried cable, power lines & trailers would also be avoided.

Waiver requests, pertaining to the recommended unorthodox location, have been sent by certified mail to all offset operators.

It is respectfully requested that the unorthodox location be approved administratively after the waivers have been reviewed and/or the 20 day waiting period has elapsed without objection from the offset operators.
