It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Johnston Well No. 6-X, located 1168 feet from the South line and 1090 feet from the West line of said Section 10.

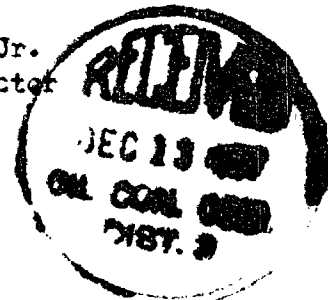

Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated November 4, 1992, 1992 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Jackson Well No. 3 which was drilled in 1982 and completed in the Basin Dakota Pool at a previously approved (Division Administrative Order NSL-1001, dated December 18, 1978) unorthodox gas well location 1430 feet from the South line and 1140 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 10, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Basin Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, all of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the well forming a non-standard 270.36-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 6 and 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location and non-standard gas proration unit are hereby approved.
