This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco Mesa Verde pool.

It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's Standard Oil Com #1A at 2235' from the North line and 790' from the West line of Section 36, T-29-N, R-9-W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Largo Canyon and Largo Wash cover the northwest corner of this section and this makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

All operators of proration units offsetting the proposed unorthodox location have been notified of this application by certified mail.
