We request permission to drill two injection wells on the referenced unit to test the feasibility of changing the injection pattern from 80 acre to 40 acre. Also, we must have approval to drill on or near boundaries and legal sub-divisions in order to accomplish our goal. The enclosed copy of a letter from the U.S.G.S. indicates their approval of this pilot test.

This field was drilled on 40 acre spacing and water flooded with 80 acre five spot patterns. We feel this program by-passed economical recoverable oil.

The attached map shows the original 80 acre pattern outlined in blue. The proposed 40 acre pattern in outlined in red. The injection wells would be at the corners of the red squares.

2540 We wish to drill two wells to test our theory. They are Navajo "F" 147, located 5' from North line and (2545) from West line, Section 9 - T31N-R17W and Navajo "F" 148 located 1200' from North line and 1410' from East line, Section 9 - T31N - (R13W) They are the red corners with red circles. -17-W

We intend to complete these wells initially as producers. After testing to determine oil - water ratios they will be converted to water injection.

The closest offset operator is 2545' West of our Navajo "F" 147. We don't feel notification of offset operators is necessary at this time.

The attached schematic drawing shows the method we will use to complete hesepprove bingection wells.
