Gentlemen:

Please accept this as our application for approval to drill the subject well located at an unorthodox location as set forth above. This well is located in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs field and is to test the Pictured Cliffs zone at a total depth of approximately 3600 feet. The NW 1/4 of Section 18, as above, covering 160 acres, more or less, is dedicated to this well. A copy of Form C-102 is attached for your information. The application for a permit to drill was submitted previously.

The well location, as above, was selected as being closest to the legal location (790' FNL and 790' FWL) that would be allowed by the Forrest Service due to terrain conditions. The regular location is on the edge of a ten foot deep ravine cutting a steep north slope. The general character of the terrain in the area is shown on the attached copy of the topographic map of the area. This topographic map is drawn to a scale which does not show the the less prominent terrain features due to the 40 foot contour interval.

The attached land ownership plat shows the ownership of all leases directly offsetting the NW 1/4 of Section 18 which is the proration unit dedicated to the subject well. The addresses of these offset operators are:

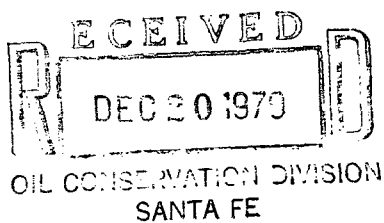

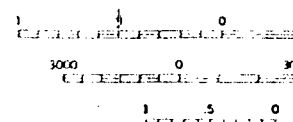
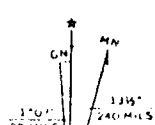
