

By this verified application submitted in triplicate, Amoco Production Company requests approval to produce gas from the Basin Dakota formation in Jack Frost "B" No. 1-E, a Basin Dakota infill well, at the unorthodox location of 615' FSL and 810' FWL of Section 27-T27N-R10W. This request supersedes my request by letter of April 1, 1980, for the unorthodox location of 910' FSL and 650' FWL of Section 27.

A Form C-102 showing the reason for this unorthodox location is enclosed. The well will be located near the Angel Peak recreation area, and the move has been made to satisfy the request of the Bureau of Land Management so as to avoid the well site being in view of a scenic overlook. This well site is an exception because the permissible location for a Basin Dakota infill well must be at least 790' from the outer boundary line of the undrilled quarter section of the 320 acre proration unit, and be at least 130' from any quarter quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary.

A plat is also enclosed which shows offset wells and operators. By the attached Verification and Affidavit that is a part of this application, all affected offset operators of Basin Dakota wells are being notified by certified mail of this
