Copies of this application are being submitted to all offset operators by certified mail with a request that they furnish your office with a waiver of objection.

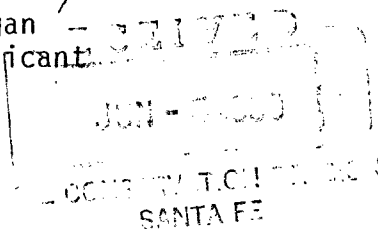

Dear Mr. Stamets:

Enclosed are enlargements of the plat previously submitted identifying the topography necessitating the non-standard location for the Lively #19E.

The plats indicate a cliff face on the southern side of Blanco Mesa. I feel it necessary to place this location 310' from the south line and 2390' from the west line in this proration unit for the following reasons:

- a) we cannot build a road on the top of Blanco Mesa because of the topography
- b) we cannot move in a northerly direction because of the cliff face

The plats enclosed clearly show the necessity for the proposed unorthodox location. If you need further information, please advise.

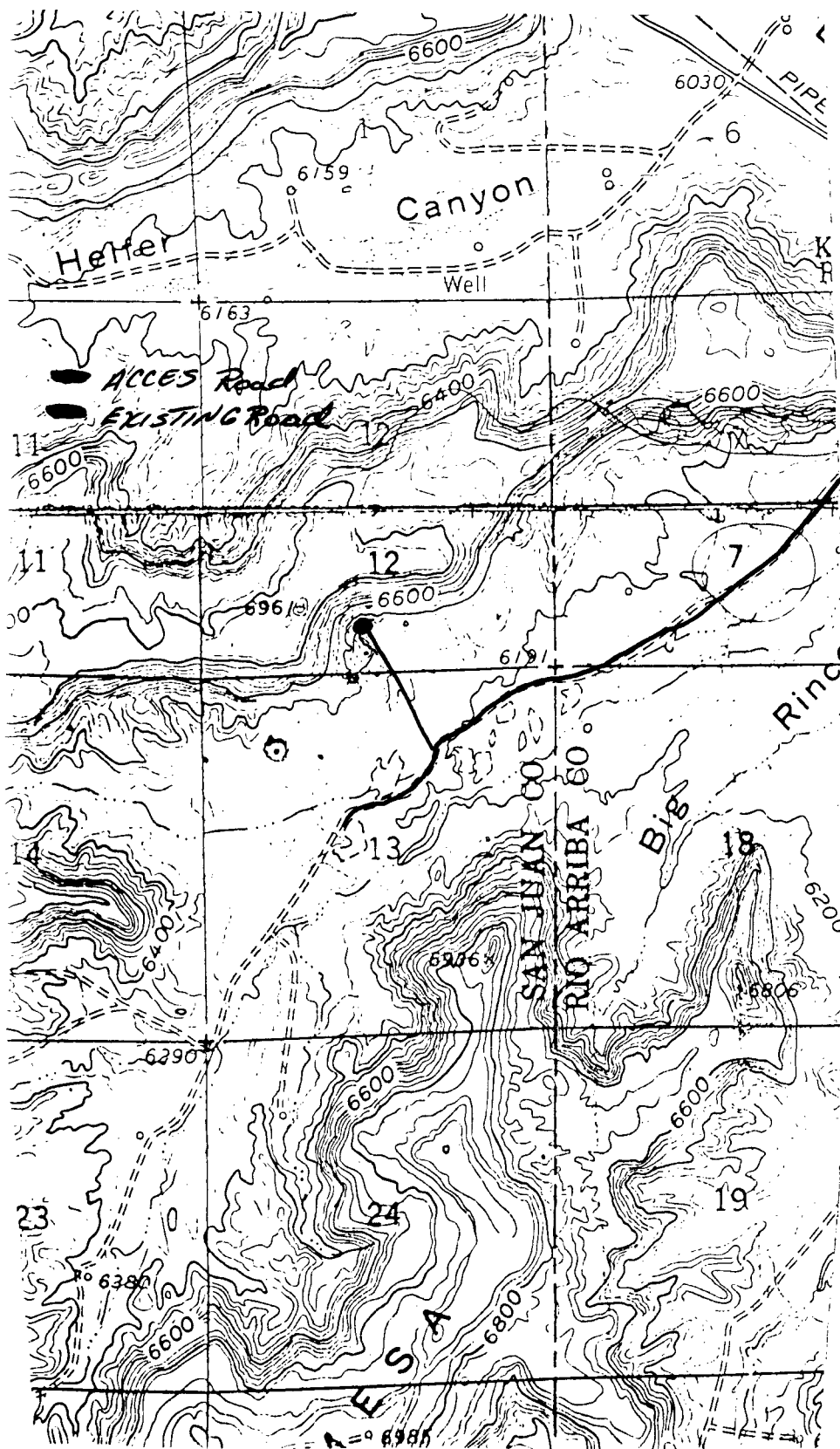

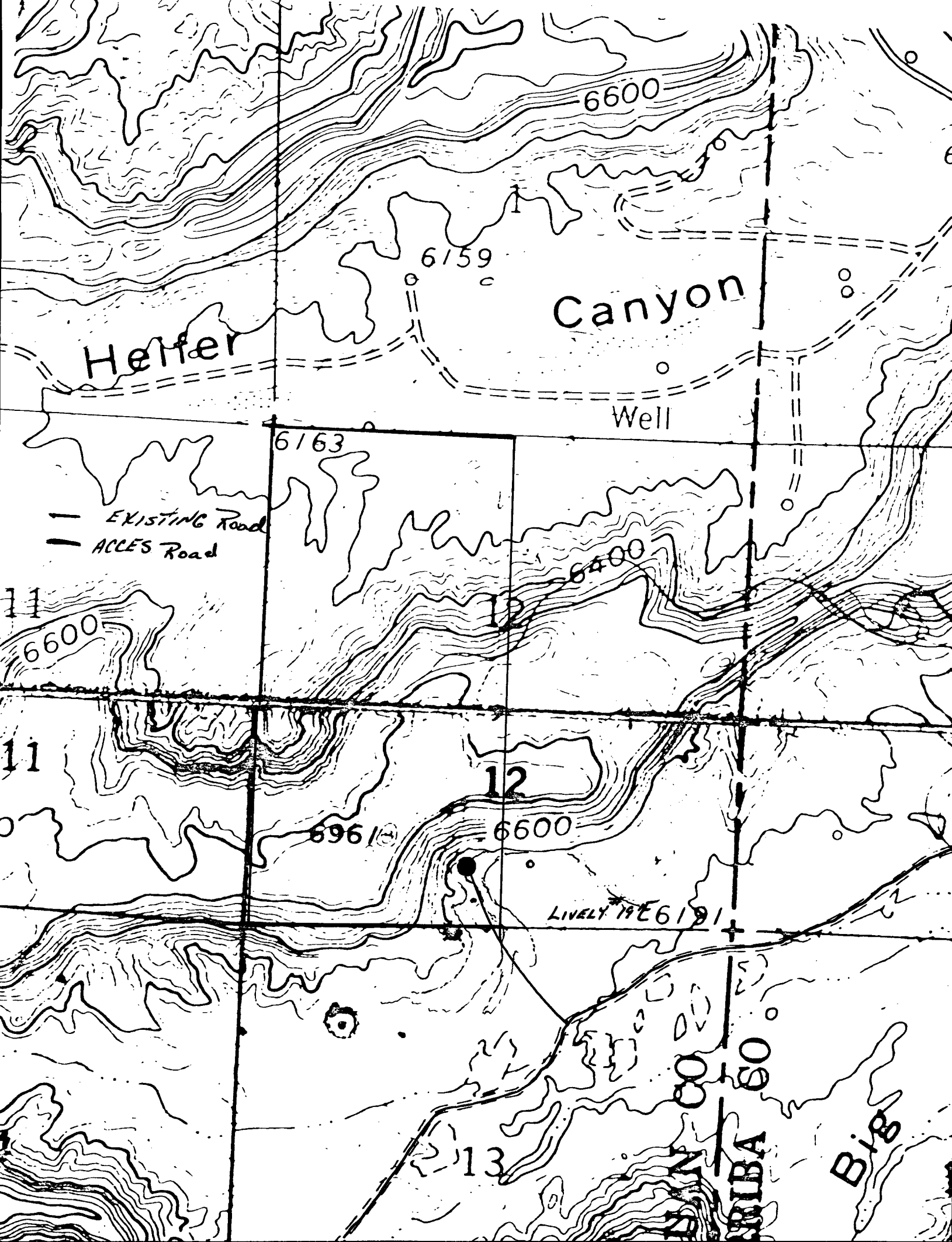
