Gentlemen:

Texas Pacific Oil Company, Inc., respectfully request administrative approval to recomplete the State "A" A/c-1 Well No. 105 at an unorthodox location, located in Unit H, 2080' from the North line and 660' from the East line of Section 23, T-23-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This well is a TA'd Langlie Mattix oil well to be recompleted as a Jalmat gas well.

The well is located within an approved 320 acre non-standard Jalmat Gas Proration unit (R-4361) for State "A" A/c-1, wells 26 and 27, simultaneous dedication is requested also, for State "A" A/c-1, Well No. 105. This approval is in the interest of conservation, will protect correlative rights, prevent economic waste, and will allow for more complete recovery of the Jalmat gas reserves.

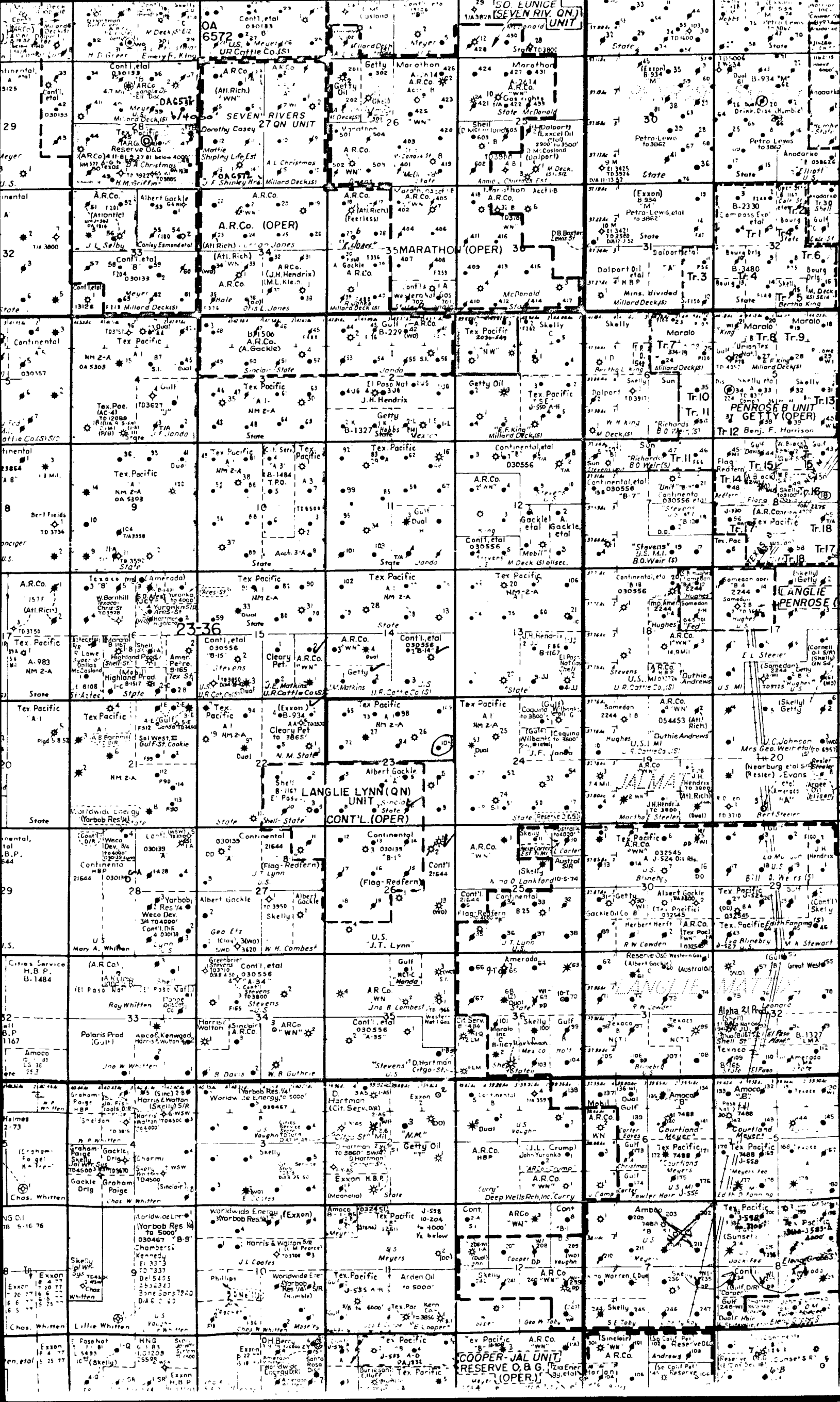
