Reference is made to your application of August 27, 1954, for approval of a <u>320-acro</u> non-standard gas promution unit covering the E/2 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 36 Mast, MPPH, Los County, New Maxico, said unit to be accribed to your Glosson Well No. 1.

By means of this application Cities Service Oil Company wishes to state the following:

1. Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of an oil and gas lease covering the E/2 of Section 6-22S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico, known as the Closson Lease, and containing 320 acres, more or less.

2. That Closson No. 1, located 2310' from the South Line and 1650' from the East Line of Section 6-225-36E, is a gas well producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool and is assigned an acreage allowable of 160 acres.

3. That the Closson No. 1 is the only gas well on the E/2 of Section 6 producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool.

4. That Order No. R-520 permits proration units of up to 640 acres in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

5. That the Closson No. 1 meets the spacing regulations for an acreage assignment of 320 acres.
