Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated February 21, 1994 <sup>(API No. 30-039-22261)</sup> for a non-standard Basin Fruitland <sup>Blanco Mesavirde</sup> coal  
gas well location for your existing Klein Well No. 28 which was drilled in 1980 and  
completed in the Basin Dakota Pool ~~at a standard~~ well location 2170 feet  
from the South line and 1840 feet from the West line (Unit K) of Section 33, Township  
26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Republica County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Blanco Mesavirde gas  
zone is to be downhole commingled with the Basin Dakota  
~~Coal Gas Pool~~ <sup>Basin Dakota</sup> and pursuant to the Special Rules and  
Regulations for the Blanco-Mesavirde ~~Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool~~, as  
promulgated by Division Order No. R-<sup>8170</sup>~~8768~~, as amended, ~~the~~  
~~said~~ <sup>also</sup> location is considered to be unorthodox.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule <sup>2(d)</sup>  
of said Order No. <sup>8170</sup>~~R-8768~~, as amended, the above-described  
unorthodox Blanco-Mesavirde gas well location is hereby approved. Further,

the Blanco-Mesavirde interval is to be dedicated to an existing ~~at said Section~~ shall  
~~be dedicated to said well forming a~~ standard 320-acre gas  
spacing and production unit, ~~the said pool~~ comprising the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of said  
Section 33, <sup>that</sup> ~~and~~ currently has dedicated thereon the Klein Well No. 7 located in Unit "D" of  
said Section 33.  
~~Also, Meridian Oil, Inc. shall comply with all other~~  
~~provisions of said Order No. R-8768, as amended, pertaining~~  
~~to the downhole commingling of coal gas production with gas~~  
~~produced from the~~ interval.
