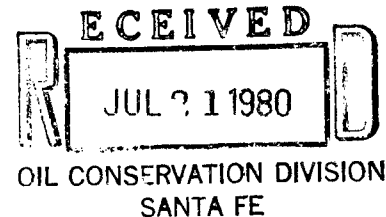

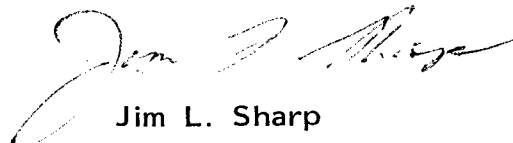

I propose to re-enter or to have re-entered the subject well and deepen from the present total depth of 10,050 feet to 11,100 feet to test the Morrow formation. 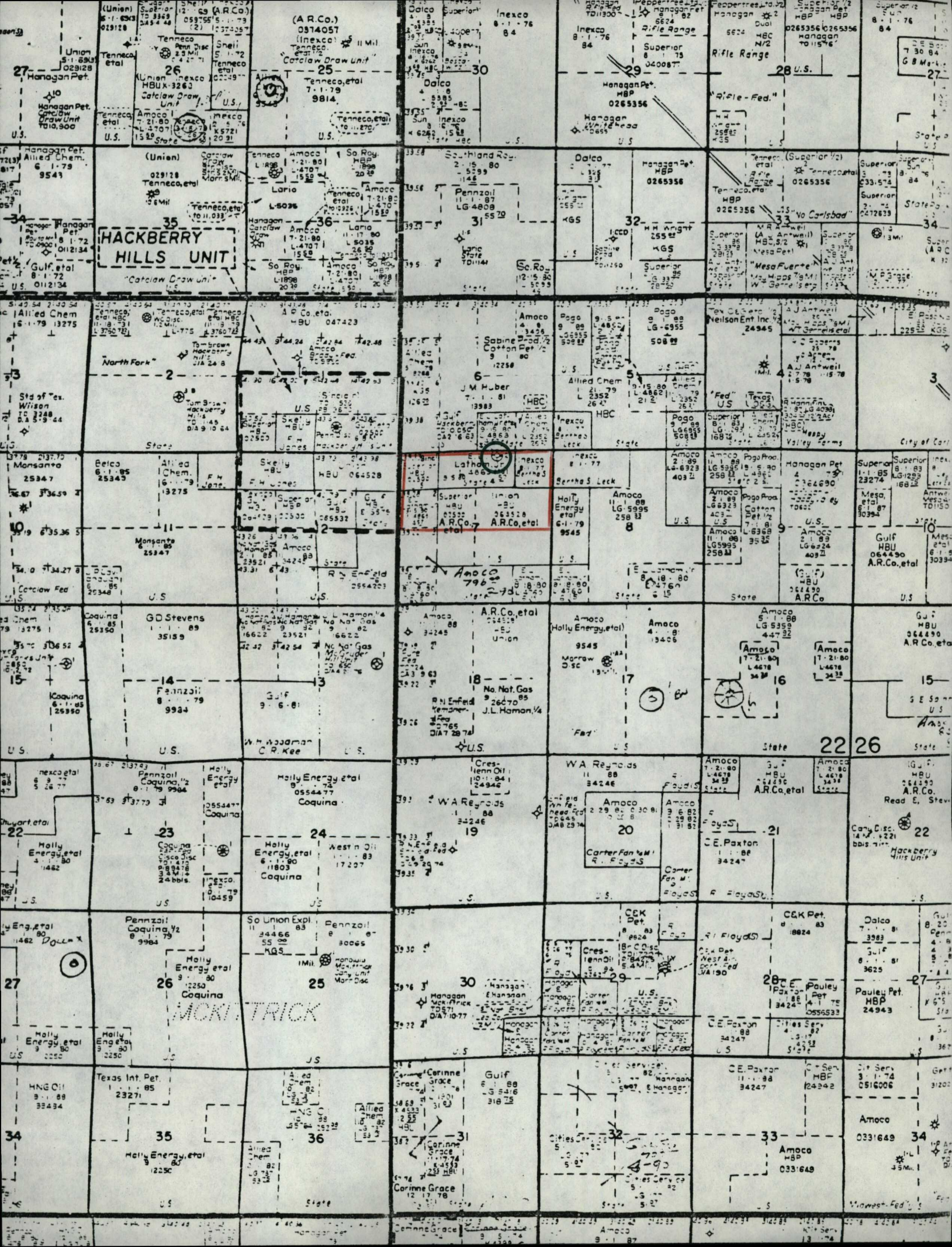

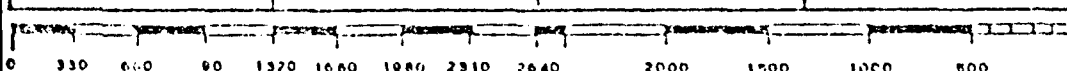

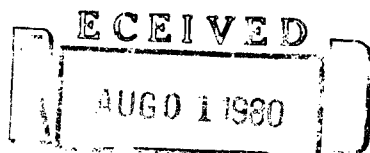
