By this verified application submitted in triplicate, Amoco Production Company requests approval to produce gas from the Basin Dakota Formation in Garcia Gas Com "B" No. 1-E, 790' FSL and 590' FWL of Section 21-T29N-R10W.

A Form C-102 is enclosed illustrating the problems encountered in selecting a suitable well site. The selected well site is an exception because the permissible location for a Basin Dakota infill well must be at least 790' from the outer boundary line of the undrilled quarter section of the 320 acre proration unit, and be at least 130' from any quarter quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary. This unorthodox location is 200' shy of the minimum permissible distance from the west boundary of the SW/4 of Section 21.

A plat also is enclosed which shows offset wells and operators. In this instance there is no offsetting acreage, other than Amoco's leaseheld acreage, that could be affected by the unorthodox location of Garcia Gas Com "B" No. 1-E. Joe D. Ramey September 24, 1980 Page Two


