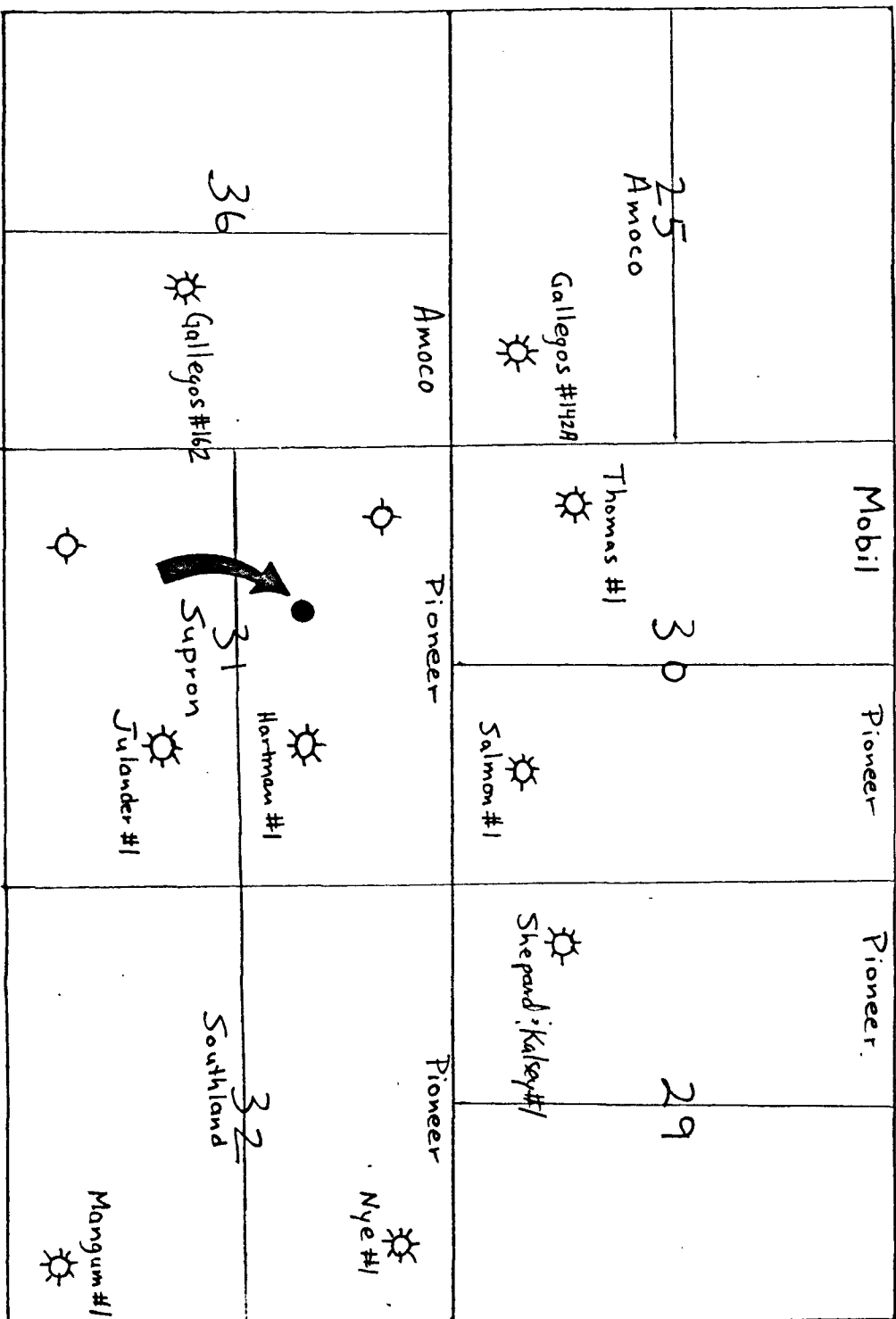

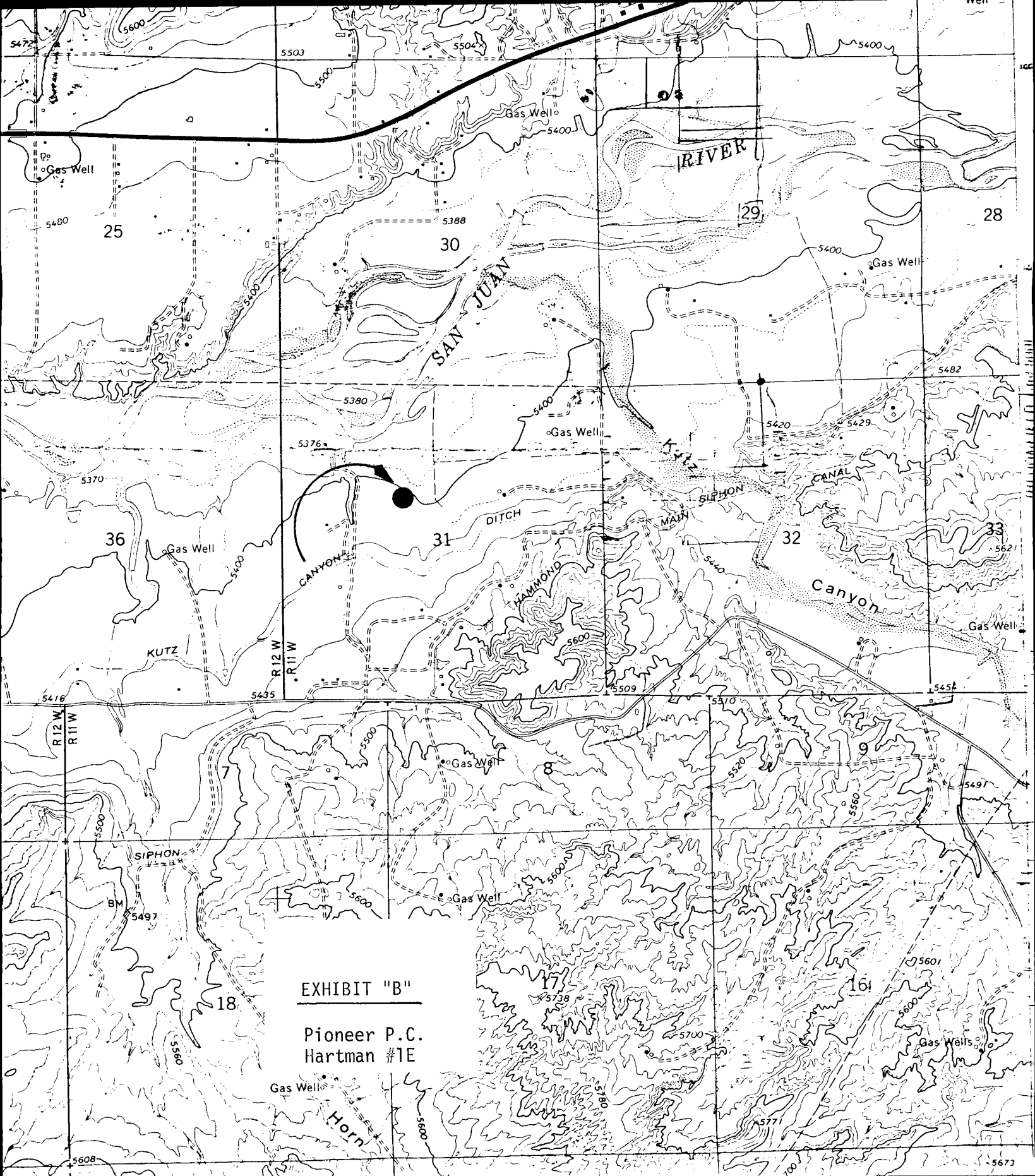

Hartman #1E

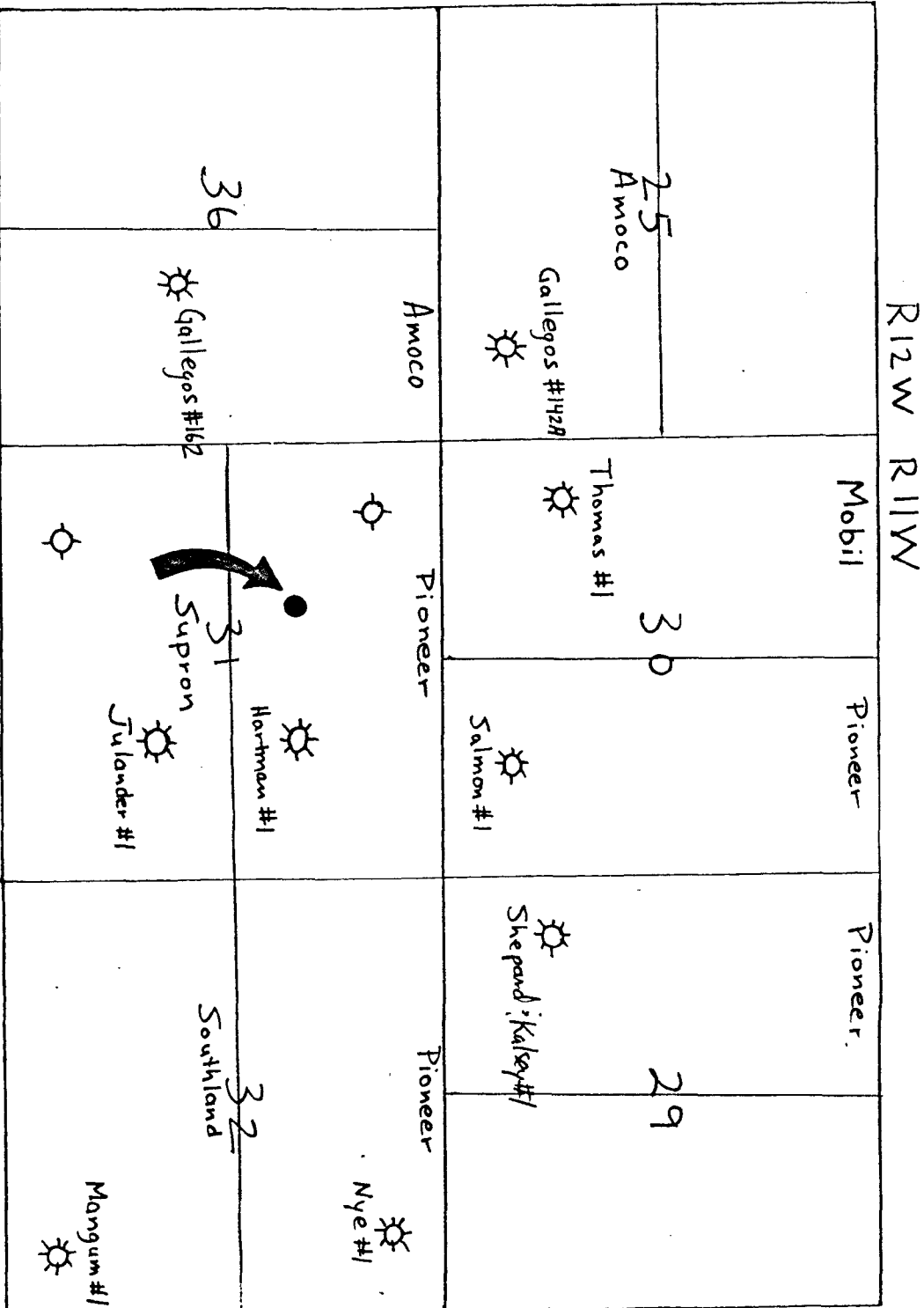
