Reason for the unorthodox location is to prevent waste by recovery of otherwise unrecoverable oil. It is believed that this can be achieved because of the previous 5-Spot waterflood injection pattern.

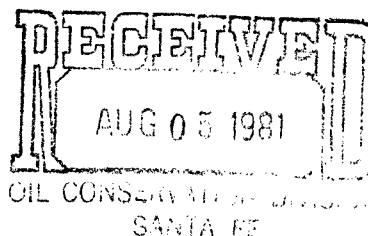
As offset operators, to the north and east of the quarter-quarter section, Arco and Cima Capitan will be notified by registered mail of our intent to drill at this location.

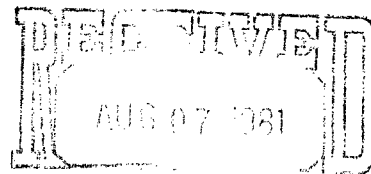

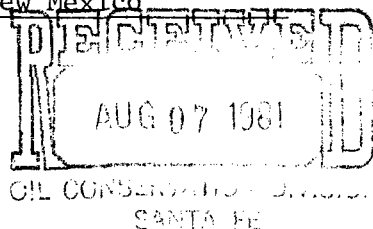


