
Amended Administrative Order NSL-1442

Dear Mr. Ball:

Reference is made to your application of July 14, 1989 to further amend Administrative Order NSL-1442 by allowing the McKamey Federal Well No. 1-Y to be plugged back and recompleted in the Undesignated East Lusk Bone Spring Pool at an existing unorthodox oil well location 2450 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of said Section 25 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the East Lusk Bone Spring Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-4994, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
