

Numbered paragraph 8 of said application letter outlined the allocation formula for allocating gas production and sales. Since the proposed commingling action involves Navajo Allotted leases the formula used for allocating gas production and sales must be changed to conform with Allotted CDP guidelines. For this commingling action, Coleman Oil & Gas, Inc. will allocate the gas production and sales according to the Guidelines for Surface Commingling and / or Off-lease Sales, Storage, Usage and Measurement for Navajo Allotted Leases.

The original application letter dated May 19, 2003 is hereby amended to incorporate these changes.
