

Dear Sir:

Anadarko Production Company respectfully requests administrative approval to drill the Ballard Grayburg San Andres Unit Well #8-6 at an unorthodox location 330 feet from the north line and 2500 feet from the west line of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This application was previously filed with a different well location of 380' from the north line and 2600' from the west line (letter dated February 17, 1982), and was approved by Administrative Order NSL - 1494. We now have found it necessary to restake the location at 330 feet from the north line and 2500 feet from the west line.

The Ballard Grayburg San Andres Unit waterflood was authorized March 16, 1973 by Order Number R-4493. Paragraph 6 of this order provides for administrative approval of such unorthodox locations.

The proposed well will be completed as a producer in the Grayburg zone. The location will be closer than 330 feet to an inner subdivision boundary, therefore making it unorthodox. It will, however be located 330 feet from the Unit boundary. A producing well is required in this area to produce waterflood oil not recoverable from existing wells.

Attached is a copy of form C-102 showing the proposed unorthodox location. Thank you for your consideration of this matter.






