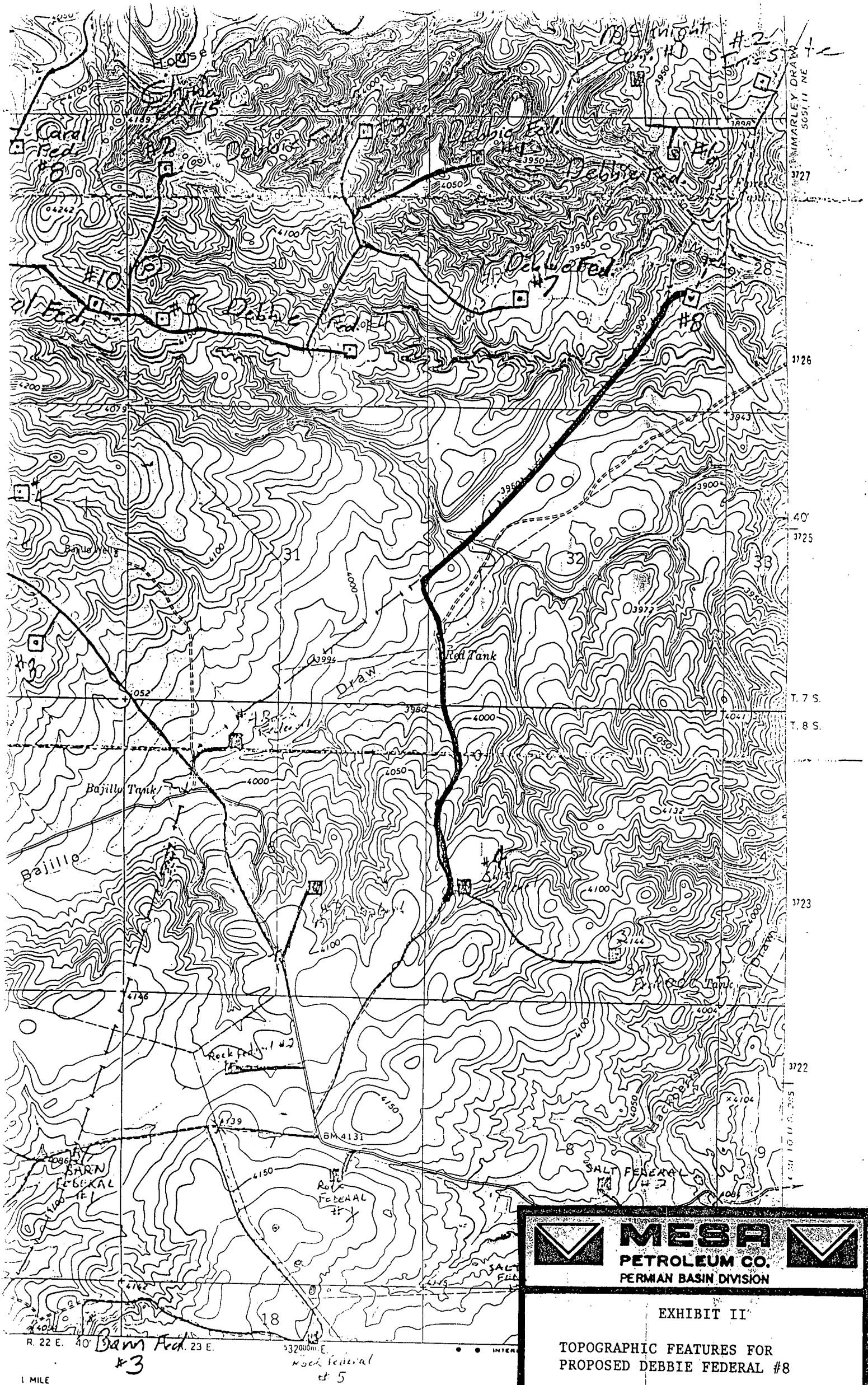

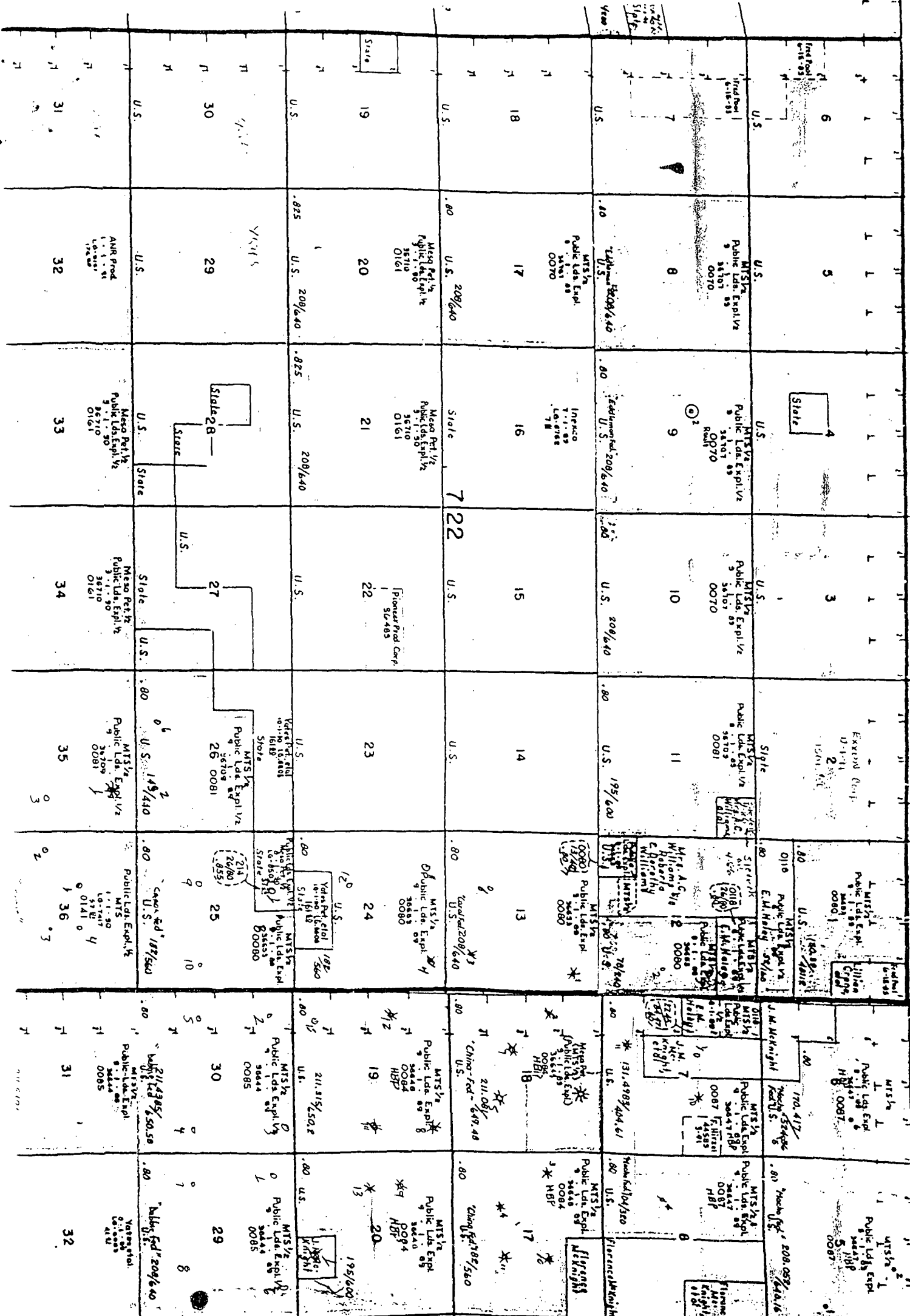
EXHIBIT II
