

McClellan Oil Corporation would appreciate an adminstrative approval for a non standard Abo gas well location, as provided for under NMOCD Rule 104F.

The enclosed map shows the topography problem and U.S. Highway 70 to the South. The topography problem is a result of the presence of an abandoned sand and gravel pit in this area. Thus, we were unable to stake our preferred location of 1980' FSL & 1980' FWL. We are requesting administrative approval for this location for topographical reasons and the presence of U.S. Highway 70 to the South.
