Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for non-standard locations for four wells in the Horseshoe-Gallup Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as follows:

Horseshoe Gallup Unit B Well No. 301, 20 feet from the North line and 1520 feet from the West line of Section 30, T-31-N, R-16-W;

Horseshoe Gallup Well No. 298, 1190 feet from the South line and 215 feet from the West line of Section 33, T-31-N, R-16-W;

Horseshoe Gallup Unit B Well No. 299, 100 feet from the South line and 1310 feet from the East line of Section 30, T-31-N, R-16-W; and

Horseshoe Gallup Unit C Well No. 300, 1590 feet from the North line and 1460 feet from the East line of Section 4, T-30-N, R-16-W.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 11 of Order No. R-2210, the above-described unorthodox locations are hereby approved.
