


This well, if productive, will drain an area of the reservoir that otherwise would not be produceable. McClellan Oil Corporation, as well as Stephens Engineering, feels that the above captioned test is the best location to drill the well as an alternate location in this area could result in a less productive well or possibly a dry hole.
