

A small grass fire occurred when a jumper to a transformer failed and dropped hot wiring to the ground which resulted in a small grass fire. The affected area consisted of a 50' x 100' patch of ranch land.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Two COPC employees determined they could extinguish the fire by utilizing portable fire extinguishers and commenced to extinguish the fire. The employees stood by for 15 minutes to ensure that the fire would not re-ignite.

It was determined that the power lines and poles belonged to Lea County Electric, meter station #26518.
