Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for your Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 222E to be located 790 feet from the South line and 630 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, Basin-Dakota and Totah-Gallup Pools, San Juan County, New Mexico. Lots 1, 2, and 3, the SE/4 SW/4, and the S/2 SE/4 of partial Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 13 West, plus Lots 2, 3, 4, and 5, and the SE/4 SW/4 of partial Section 7, Township 28 North, Range 12 West, comprising 364.58 acres shall be dedicated to the Basin-Dakota Pool and the S/2 SE/4 of Section 12, Township 28 North, Range 13 West, comprising 80 acres, shall be be dedicated to the Totah Gallup Pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
