



LEGAL NOTICE Marbob Energy Corporation, Post Office Box 227, Artesia, New Mexico, 88211-0227, has filed Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval to expand the injection interval from 2677-3958' to 2677-6484' for a salt water disposal well. The proposed well, the South Malaga I-2-25-28 SWD (formerly the Hoss BHK State No. 1) is located T880' PSC and 660' FEL, Section 2, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Disposal water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Delaware formation. The disposal water will be injected into the Delaware and Bone Spring formations at a depth of 2677-6484' at a maximum surface pressure of 535 psi and a maximum rate of 3000 BWPD. Any interested party who has an objection to this must give notice in writing to the Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South Saint Francis Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505, within fifteen (15) days of this notice.
