Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application on behalf of J. Cleo Thompson and James Cleo Thompson, Jr. for non-standard oil well locations for their following four wells located in Township 16 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Square Lake Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico:

Tract 6 Well No. 7 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 1295 feet from the East line of Section 35. The SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to the well.


Tract 6 Well No. 8 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 2615 feet from the West line of Section 35. The SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to the well.

Tract 6 Well No. 9 to be located 720 feet from the South line and 1345 feet from the West line of Section 35. The SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to the well.

Tract 24 Well No. 12 to be located 660 feet from the South line and 1295 feet from the East line of Section 36. The SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 36 shall be dedicated to the well.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F(I), the above-described unorthodox locations are hereby approved.
