Dear David:

This letter constitutes an application for administrative approval for the above described unorthodox location. The well which has been drilled at that location was originally permitted as an oil well but has turned out to be a gas well. I understand that you have discussed this with Tenneco Oil Company personnel in San Antonio.

We understand that Cibola is the off-setting operator on the North, South, East, and West of the location. You should expect a telephone call and written confirmation of their waiver of any objection to this unorthodox location.

In addition, we need administrative approval for a stand up 320-acre proration unit, consisting of the E/2 of Section 19. Again, you can expect to receive both verbal and written waivers from Cibola to the stand up proration unit.

The drilling permit has been filed with the Artesia office and I understand that you will contact Artesia if you need additional information.
