## Dear Bill:

Reference is made to your application dated October 1, 1991 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Pollock Com "E" Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1983 and dually completed in the Armenta Gallup Oil Pool and Blanco Mesaverde Pool at a standard location for both zones 860 feet from the South line and 805 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that both the Gallup and Mesaverde zones will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the E/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
