ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on March 16, 1982, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this 26th day of March, 1982, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Sun Oil Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant further seeks a 120-acre non-standard proration unit comprising the W/2 NE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 22.
- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(6) That approval of the subject application will affor the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That Sun Oil Company is hereby authorized an unorthodox gas well location for a well to be located at a point 1980 feet from the North line and 1400 feet from the East line of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) That a 120-acre non-standard proration unit comprising the W/2 NE/4 and SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 22 is hereby approved for the above-described well.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
