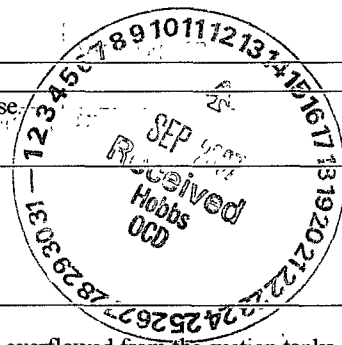

Lightning storm early AM on Sept 9, 2007 caused electrical damage and shut injection station down. Produced water overflowed from the suction tanks to the overflow tank. As water level rose gas was vented out the enardo valve on the tank. Lightning apparently lit the gas vapors resulting in a very small flame. Lovington Fire Department was called upon discovery and had the flame extinguished shortly after arrival. There was no damage to any equipment.
