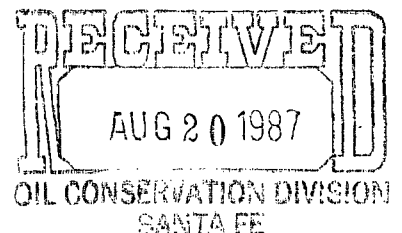
Please be advised that Apache Oil Corporation hereby waives any objection to protest said unorthodox location as to the Morrow formation and all formations above said Morrow formation.
