Attached is a copy of an administrative application for NMOCD approval for an unorthodox well location.

The Madera Federal 24 #1 was completed on 4/29/05 as a gas well. Since that time, the GOR of the well has dropped to below 8700, necessitating reclassification as an oil well. Reclassification as an oil well results in this well being in an unorthodox location. Review of location plats indicate that Chevron owns all acreage within a 40 acre spacing unit of the Madera Federal 24 #1 location. Therefore, notification of offset operators is not required.


