Reference is made to your application for a non-standard location for four wells as described below:

Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 258: 2630 feet from the South line and 1320 feet from the West line of Section 31. The NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well:

Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 260: 2441 feet from the South line and 1330 feet from the West line of Section 29. The NE/4 SW/4 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well;

Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 261: 1330 feet from the South line and 1220 feet from the West line of Section 31. The NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well;

Myers Langlie Mattix Unit No. 262: 2541 feet from the South line and 107 feet from the West line of Section 31. The NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 31 shall be dedicated to the well;

All wells are located in Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen Grayburg Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
