- I. The well is staked on Navajo Tribal Trust surface and on Navajo Tribal Trust oil and gas lease NO-G-0402-1710. The proposed location is nonstandard for the Wildcat 32N19W32; Leadville Gas due to geology. A standard location must be at least 660' from the quarter section line. This well is staked 122' further south than is standard. (Closest standard location would be 660' FSL and 1553' FWL.) The APD cover sheet is attached as EXHIBIT A.
- II. A C-102 showing the well location and pro ration unit (SW4 Section 32) is attached (EXHIBIT B). The Tribal oil and gas lease (12,160 acres) boundary is marked as a solid line on the attached (EXHIBIT C) topographic map. The Navajo Nation is the lessor and the Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc. is the lessee for the SW4 Section 32 and all adjacent 8 quarter sections. The well is 3,727' from the closest lease line.

The well encroaches on the NW4 Section 5, T. 31 N., R. 19 W. There are no existing wells, nor any planned wells, in that pro ration unit. Nor are there any existing producing wells in any of the 8 surrounding quarter sections. The only well of any type in the SW4 Section 32 or the adjacent 8 sections is the P & A Navajo 32 #1 which is 444' northeast at 660' FSL & 1980' FWL 32-32n-19w.

III. The closest existing or planned well is the Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc. proposed Falcon 6-I #1 well. That well is staked at 2322' FSL & 207' FEL 6-31n-19w, or 3,914' southwest. EXHIBIT D shows the proposed NSL well, all existing wells (none), all planned wells (none), and existing or possible gas 160 acre spacing units.

There are no offset interest owners. Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc. is

the operator all all eight existing or potential offsetting 160 acre pro ration units - all of which are part of the same lease.

- IV. A copy of the USGS map is attached (EXHIBIT D). The proposed well site is marked. Pro ration unit (solid line) for the WC31N19W32; Leadville Gas is the 160 acre southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 32 North, Range 19 West, San Juan County, NM.
- V. The nonstandard location is due to geology. A standard location would need to be 122' further north. Location is critical. A dry hole (Mesa's Navajo 32 #1; API # 30-045-20364) was drilled 444' away in the center of the quarter-quarter. However, the proposed location is based on 3-D seismic (see Exhibit E (well has since been renamed from Hawk 32-M-1 to Hawk 32-N #1)) and the applicant will try to produce from three zones (Ismay, Desert Creek, and Leadville). The Exhibit F maps shows the P & A Mesa well (dark circle 72393 on maps) off the flank of the algal mound. The same maps show the Hawk 32-N #1 (lighter shaded circle) on the mound.
- VI. Archaeology is not an issue.
- VII. Surface conditions are not an issue.
- VIII. Directional drilling is not feasible because it is not cost effective.
- IX. I hereby certify notice (EXHIBIT G) has been sent to the following agencies, lessees (only Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc.), lessors (only Navajo Nation), operators of existing spacing units (only Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc.), or owners of undrilled leases (only Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc.) which adjoin the applicant's spacing unit on one or more of the two sides or the single closest corner to the proposed well and that the information is current and correct. (Navajo Nation Oil & Gas Co., Inc. is the operator all all eight existing or potential offsetting 160 acre gas pro ration units.)


Canal Creek Project <u>East-West Line crossing Hawk Well</u> <u>Prospect 3</u>




