

Initial equipment removal was conducted prior to the corrective action due date of August 23, 2007 as discussed with Inspector Buddy Hill. Preliminary delineation of site contamination was performed on September 13, 2007. A site plan denoting trench locations and associated analytical results are included herein.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Hydrocarbon impacted soils exceeding clean-up limitations set by the OCD are to be excavated and removed from the site. Contaminated soils are to be transported to Lazy Ace Landfarm for remediation purposes. Those soils exceeding 1000 ppm Cl will be sent to CRI for disposal.
