Reference is made to your application of July 13, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Grambling "C" Well No. 200 to be located 1180 feet from the North line and 605 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, Undesignated Blanco Fruitland Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The applicant proposes to dedicated Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of said Irregular Section 12 to the well forming a non-standard 142.74 acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.
