Reference is made to your application of October 18, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Carracas Unit 30-B Well No. 8 to be located 2240 feet from the North line and 620 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 30, Township 32 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, to test the Fruitland (Sand) formation, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
