Reference is made to your application of November 18, 1988 for a non-standard oil well location for your Eunice Monument South Unit Well No. 643 to be located 1275 feet from the South and East lines (Unit X) of Irregular Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Grayburg formation, Eunice Monument South Waterflood Project, Lea County, New Mexico.
