Reference is made to your application of October 13, 1988 on behalf of Jack A. Cole for a non-standard oil well location for your Rincon Well No. 1 to be located 1080 feet from the North line and 2160 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Undesignated Escrito-Gallup Associated Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 NW/4 of said Section 30 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of Division Order R-5353, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
