Dear Mr. Blancett:

Reference is made to your application of January 20, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location for your proposed Rincon Well No. 7 to be located 330 feet from the North line and 2070 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 6, Township 23 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Counselors Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The NE/4 (equivalent) of said Section 6, forming a standard 160-acre, more or less, oil spacing and proration unit for said pool, shall be simultaneously dedicated to said well and to the applicant's existing Mancos "A" Well No. 2 located at a standard oil well location 1980 feet from the North and East lines (Unit G) of said Section 6.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Counselors Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-7034, as amended, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
