Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests your approval of our administrative application for the subject Unorthodox Gas Well Location and Simultaneous Dedication.

Chevron is planning to re-complete it's W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well No. 28 in the Eumont Yates 7-Rvrs Qn (Pro Gas) Pool. It is our desire to simultaneously dedicate an existing 480-acre Eumont Gas Proration Unit assigned to our W. A. Ramsay (NCT-A) Well Nos. 14 and 24 (NSL-2721 SD and Order No. R-596) to all three wells. As a result, the location of the W. A. Ramsay Well No. 28 is unorthodox in that it is less than 990' from the outer boundary of the proration unit. The location of Well No. 28 is 660 feet FSL and 1980 feet FEL of Section 34, T-21-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

In order to prevent waste, Chevron respectfully requests your approval of this administrative application for an unorthodox gas well location and simultaneous dedication under the provisions of Rule 104 (F). Attached is a map showing offset



Dear Mr. Bohling:

Reference is made to your application of October 23, 1989 for a non-standard gas well location for your W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well No. 24 located 1920 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be simultaneously dedicated, with the W.A. Ramsey (NCT-A) Well No. 14 located 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of said Section 34, to the previously approved 480-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit (Division Order No. R-596, dated February 28, 1955) comprising the N/2 and SE/4 of said Section 34.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.

Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from both of the aforementioned wells on the proration unit in any proportion.

THE APPLICATION OF THE COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION, DIRECTED TO GULF OIL CORPORATION, FOR RECONSIDERATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NSP-59 WHICH CREATED A NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT IN THE JALMAT GAS POOL CONSISTING OF THE N/2 AND SE/4 OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 16, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 28th day of February, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and testimony adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That pursuant to provisions of Rule 5 (a) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-520, the Commission has power and authority to permit the formation of a gas proration unit consisting of other than a legal section after notice and hearing by the Commission.
- (3) That applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of an oil and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico the land consisting of other than a legal section, and described as follows, to-wit:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM N/2, SE/4 of Section 34

containing 480 acres, more or less.

- (4) That applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, has a producing well on the aforesaid lease known as W. A. Ramsay State Well No. 17, located 1980 feet from the north and west lines of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (5) That the above described 480-acre non-standard gas proration unit has been producing under the provisions of Administrative Order NSP-59, and that the Gulf Oil Corporation was required to, and did, show cause why this 480-acre proration unit should not be reduced in size.
- (6) That it is impractical to pool applicant's said lease with adjoining acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool, and that the owners of adjoining acreage in said area have not objected to the formation of the proposed proration unit of 480-acres.
- (7) That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aforesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool.
- (8) That creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage will not cause but will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the application of Gulf Oil Corporation for approval of an unorthodox proration unit consisting of the following described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM N/2, SE/4 of Section 34

be and the same is hereby approved, and a proration unit consisting of aforesaid acreage is hereby created.

(2) That applicant's William A. Ramsay State Well No. 17, located in SE/4 NW/4 of Section 34, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, shall be granted an allowable in the proportion that the above described 480-acre unit bears to the standard or orthodox proration unit for said pool, all until further order of the Commission.

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 480-acre nonstandard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:
