> Amended Administrative Order NSL-2702

Dear Mr. Bruce:

Reference is made to your applications dated October 4, and November 6, 1991 to include the Avalon Strawn Gas and Avalon Atoka Gas Pools in the provisions of Division Administrative Order NSL-2702, dated October 23, 1989, which order authorized Mewbourn Oil Company to test the Avalon Morrow Gas Pool at an unorthodox gas well location 990 feet from South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the Morrow interval in the Federal "Q" Well No. 1 has been plugged back and the well was recompleted in the Atoka zone and will subsequently be perforated in the Strawn formation. Further, the W/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit in both pools.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104F.(1) said Order NSL-2702 is hereby amended to include both the Strawn and Atoka formations.

All other provisions of said Order NSL-2702 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
