Dear Ms. Carruth:

Reference is made to your application of December 4, 1989 for a non-standard oil well location to permit the completion of an efficient production/injection pattern within an active secondary recovery project for your Langlie Mattix-Queen Well No. 41 to be located 1300 feet from the North and East lines (Unit A) of Section 15, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen Pool, (Mobil) Langlie Mattix Unit Waterflood Project Area, Lea County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 15, which is presently dedicated to the Langlie Mattix Queen Unit Well No. 12 located 660 feet from the North and East lines of said Section 15.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104 F(I) and Division Order No. R-3823, dated September 4, 1969, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
